The following action was taken by the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona on September 9, 2025, regarding to the above-referenced cause:

ORDERED: Plaintiff/Appellant's Petition for Review = GRANTED.

FURTHER ORDERED: The case shall be set for oral argument.

FURTHER ORDERED: The parties may file simultaneous supplemental briefs, not to exceed 20 pages in length, no later than September 29, 2025. Any amicus briefs are due on or before October 14, 2025 and any responses to amicus briefs are due on or before November 3, 2025. Any amicus briefs or responses may not exceed 20 pages in length.

FURTHER ORDERED: Request for Attorneys' Fees (Appellant Goldwater Institute) = CONTINUED.

Justice Cruz did not participate in the determination of this matter.

Filing a supplemental brief is permissive rather than mandatory. This order is not an invitation to repeat the contents of the Petition for Review, the Response, or any Reply. Lack of a supplemental brief is not an admission that the opposing party or parties' position should prevail.

Counsel will be advised of the oral argument date and time when the hearing date is determined.

The Clerk of the Court of Appeals, Division One, Phoenix, must forward the remaining record to the Clerk of the Supreme Court.
